The Market was back in full force this season! We brought back all of our programming: Music at the Market, Kids Market Bucks Club, Chef at the Market, and Free Yoga Classes thanks to our incredibly generous sponsors. We were also able to provide monthly Master Gardeners classes, our annual Back to School Day, and we introduced a Senior Citizen Day and Pet Parade this year.

Every week the community had the opportunity to donate produce to Kitsap Harvest (our total was 925 pounds!), pick up applications for the Farmers Market Nutrition Program, obtain free COVID test kits and masks, and EBT customers were able to benefit from the SNAP Market Match program where they received up to \$40 in matching dollars to spend on fresh fruits and vegetables.
